Art and Cartooning is a course that allows you to explore, express, and demonstrate your ideas and emotions visually. To be successful, you must learn skills and practice techniques through a series of structured projects.

- This is a studio and project based course that will introduce and expand on the basics of visual arts and cartooning skills; there will be the use of a variety of 2 and 3 dimension mediums, concepts, and themes.
- We will be exploring various aspects of The Elements and Principles of Art and Design and Cartooning Elements in various projects.
- As you develop your abilities and confidence, you will find ways of expressing yourself that will give you satisfaction and allow you to understand and appreciate the many forms of artistic expression found around you.

Benchmarks of E-P-S-ED will be used in Home Logic while 4-3-2-1 will be used in for the stems and Report Cards.

Understanding - Analyzes, Evaluates, and Responds critically to Art/Cartooning

• The student demonstrates understanding of concepts covered in class and is able to Analyze, Evaluate, and Respond critically throughout Art/Cartooning projects.

Classroom Expectations:
